Bus

Please make sure you have places booked for the school bus in the morning as well as the afternoon. Bookings close the day before the travel day so you do need to be in advance, any last minute bookings need to be done through the school office. The service will only be able to continue if people use it as we have to cover all of our costs as it is not subsidised by the local authority.

The morning bus is getting much busier so all journeys MUST be booked and paid for in advance.

Uniform

The children look absolutely fab in their uniform and we ask that you pay full attention to the uniform policy and our expectations as the little things like not wearing trainers all week or not wearing patterned socks instead of plain ones make a big difference. We understand that things happen, but I think it important to start the year as we mean to go on.

- The uniform does not have to be one with a school logo on. We are happy for children to wear blue jumpers
 or cardigans as long as they are plain and have no other logo. All of the major retailers stock such items as
 very reasonable prices.
- We insist that children do not wear make-up, that children do not have inappropriate hairstyles (tramlines; excessively dyes; loose braids) and that any ear jewellery is restricted to plain and small studs.
- Nail varnish/acrylics/false nails and fake tattoos are not suitable and need to be removed before school.
- Children must not wear trainers for any day other than games day and on other days shoes must be worn. This means we do not allow boots or sandals.

P.E. Hoodies / Used Uniform

P.E. Hoodies - Ordering P.E. hoodies is now open through ParentPay. This will close on Friday 27th September and there is a 2-3 week turnaround from the suppliers.

Used Uniform – thank you for all the kind donations. A couple of points...

- We are now only recycling branded uniform such as jumpers/cardigans/p.e. hoodies space is at a premium in school and we cannot store other uniform.
- Please remove any names from uniform you donate; it saves a lot of confusion!

School Meal Increase.....

School meals have increased to £2.70 per day/£13.50 per week. We've held off increasing the daily cost from April until this term.

A reminder that if you think you may be eligible for Pupil Premium; which also covers the cost of school meals throughout the time your child will be here; it is worth checking through Lancashire's Online Portal – a very quick and simple form to complete.
