

# RECEPTION CLASS SUMMER TERM

## AS CREATORS WE ARE...

ART: Exploring colour and colour-mixing. Sharing our creations, explaining the processes we have used. Safely using a variety of materials, tools and techniques.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: We will be exploring the differences between fruit and vegetables, then using these to create fruit kebabs and vegetable soup.

MUSIC: Singing a melody in waltz time and perform actions. Composing a three-beat body percussion pattern and performing it to a steady beat.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Fundamental skills-refining gymnastic skills of jumping, rolling and travelling across apparatus.

Developing a range of ball skills including throwing, catching, kicking, passing, batting and aiming. Develop confidence and accuracy during ball-skill activities.

# AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE...

GEOGRAPHY: We will be looking at some of the features of our local environment and comparing places on Google Earth – how are they similar/different?

HISTORY: We will explore similarities and differences between transport in the past and now. We will learn about some significant figures who have been to space and begin to understand that these events happened before the children were born.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: 'Special places' - we will be learning about the features of some holy places-churches, mosques and temples.

SPEAKING AND LISTENING: Using new vocabulary in different contexts. Using talk to clarify thinking, connect ideas and share thinking with others.

COMPUTING: Learning the importance of giving precise instructions.
