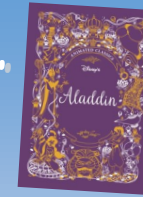

YEAR 2 Summer Term

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: Expressive Painting

We will focus on developing our skills by looking at expressionism. We will look at primary and secondary colours through expressive mark making, connecting colour and texture.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Picnic Wraps

We will be looking at a balanced diet before designing, making and evaluating

MUSIC: Tańczymy labada

This unit is based around a welcoming Polish circle game with increasingly tricky actions, which will help to develop children's sense of beat. We will sing, play an accompaniment, and invent a 4-beat body percussion pattern.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Striking and Fielding, Net and Wall, Orienteering

We will look at striking a ball for distance and simple tactics within games. We will look at how to hold bats to maximise striking the ball and catching balls in a ready position. We will look at working together as a team to find our way around a trail.

Come and join us to see our favourite learning from the term

AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

This term we will look at fractions and apply this to both shapes and amounts. We will look at statistics and simple tables and bar charts. We will look at time and how to tell time to the nearest quarter hour.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will be studying Aladdin, using both the text and film versions for comparison. We will look at a variety of writing styles including diaries, letters, setting descriptions, persuasion and narrative chapters. We will be focusing on all the writing skills needed to achieve these well. We will also look at the text of The Wind in the Willows, focusing on an adventure story and characters.

Outdoor learning sessions take place each week.

AS SCIENTISTS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: Plants, Living Things & Habitats, Life Cycles

We will continue our study of plants by exploring conditions they need to grow and make conclusions. We will explore the life cycles of animals by noticing that animals have offspring which become adults. We will look at a variety of different habitats and how plants and animals depend on each other as well as identifying different food chains.

GEOGRAPHY: Let's go to Mexico

We will look at the country of Mexico in terms of location within the world and its human and physical features. We will compare an area of Mexico to our area in the UK.

HISTORY: Who was Amelia Earhart and why is she remembered?

We will look at the history of flight focusing on the achievements of Amelia Earhart by looking on her being a pioneer for her time and why this is important.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Christianity and Judaism

We will look at the different features of a church and the ways Christians worship. We will look at the story of Moses and the Ten Commandments. We will explore Jewish beliefs and values about how to live in accordance with the Torah.

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Programming

We will use Scratch to create a simple animation and follow algorithms. We will plan and use code to create an algorithm.

AS YOUNG PEOPLE WE ARE...

PSHE: Rights and Responsibilities and Growing & Changing

We will focus on cooperation and self-regulation strategies. We will think how we have grown and changed this year and life cycles.
