SCIENCE: Evolution and Inheritance, Light

We will learn about variation and adaptation. We will examine the scientific evidence from plants and animals that has been gathered to support the theory of evolution. In Light, we will learn about light, how we see, shadows, reflection and refraction. We will learn how light travels and how this enables us to see objects.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE...

GEOGRAPHY: Enough for Everyone

Year 6 will learn about the needs of a settlement, and the needs of the planet as a whole. They will find out where resources such as power and food come from, and look at ways in which natural resources can be conserved.

HISTORY: Early Civilisations
