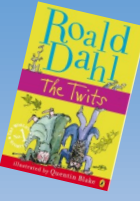

Our Nativity Play, Toy Museum and Classroom Music Performance

AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

We will be building on our work in Reception, by further exploring the numbers 1 to 10, and comparing their values. We will also be looking at a range of strategies, to help with solving addition and subtraction problems, and investigating 2D and 3D shapes.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will be looking at the story of Harry the Happy Mouse and exploring and performing rhymes.

We will also be reading Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers, and using the text as inspiration to write non-chronological reports and poems about penguins.

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: Drawing & Sketchbooks

We will be drawing from observation and imagination. We will explore how drawing can be an emotional and physical activity and how we can move our whole body when we draw. We will also learn to control the lines we make, by varying the pressure which we apply and the speed with which we draw.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Structures - Windmills.

We will be looking at different types of windmills, how they work, and then designing and making our own. We will then look at ways in which our design could be improved.

MUSIC: Menu Song

We will be practising our skills in listening, keeping a steady beat, and understanding pitch. We will also be learning how to echo sing a leader. We can't wait for you to see our final performance!

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: We will be developing our fundamental skills in rolling, bouncing and catching a ball. We will also be learning how to kick a ball and dancing like the characters from Toy Story.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: Animals including Humans

We will begin the term by identifying and naming the parts of the human body and exploring our senses. We will discover how we can group and name animals, using a variety of different characteristics and look at their similarities and differences. We will also look at **Seasonal Change** throughout the year.

AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE.....

GEOGRAPHY: Our School

In Geography, we will be learning about how our school was founded, and exploring it's location in comparison to Preesall village, the UK and the World. We will learn how to use a map and atlas, and also create our own maps of our school and it's surrounding area.

HISTORY: Toys

In History, we will look at how toys have changed over time, including changes in materials, how they are made and how we play with them. We will begin to understand how we can find out about toys from the past, both within and beyond living memory.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Christianity

In RE, we will explore why Christians think of God as a 'father'. We will also be looking at the events leading up to the birth of Jesus, and practising for our amazing nativity play.

We will be improving our mouse skills and creating and storing digital images.
