#### PARENT PRESENTATION

Our Nativity Play and a morning celebrating our work.

#### AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

This term we will look at place value focusing on numbers up to 100. We will work on addition and subtraction by developing written and mental methods. We will also look at shape, thinking about differences between 2D and 3D.

#### AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will look at the Way Home for Wolf, thinking about the character before creating our own story. We will research and write fact files about wolves. We will be reading some traditional tales with a twist, comparing versions to the originals before developing our own story with a twist. We will also look at instruction writing, focusing

#### AS SCIENTISTS WE ARE.....

##### SCIENCE: Materials, Habitats and Plants

We start the year with observing our habitat, which we continue with throughout the year to note changes. We will also plant bulbs which we continue to observe and watch growth. We will then look at a range of materials and their properties and look at how materials can be changed by squashing, twisting, bending and stretching.

#### AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE...

##### GEOGRAPHY: Wonderful World

In Geography we will be learning to name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans. We will be using world maps, atlases and globes to identify these and we will be looking at the location of hot and cold countries in the world. We will consider the continent we live in and neighbouring countries.

##### HISTORY: The Great Fire of London

In History we will look at what London was like in 1666, the causes of the Great Fire, how it was tackled and the impact it had on buildings and firefighting.

##### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Christianity

In RE we look at how Christians believe that God created the world and how it should be cared for. In the second half term we will look at how Christians celebrate Advent and see Jesus as a light in the world.

#### AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

##### COMPUTING: Computer Systems & Data Handling

We will start by looking at the parts and functions of computers. We will then look at how to input and retrieve data in spreadsheets.

#### AS YOUNG PEOPLE WE ARE...

##### PSHE: Me and my Relationships & Valuing Difference

We will think about a happy classroom including bullying. We will think how to be a good friend. We will discuss special people and how to make people feel included. We will think about kindness and how our actions make others feel.

#### AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

##### ART: Explore and Draw

We will look at how nature can inspire us to create art with nature and create wax resist leaf pictures to show these skills.

##### DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Moving Monsters

We will look at levers, linkages and pivots before designing, making and evaluating a moving monster.

##### MUSIC: Tony Chestnut

We will be learning a fun, fast-moving action song that has a simple tune and clever lyrics crafted to sound like different parts of the body.

##### PHYSICAL EDUCATION:

We will develop our fundamental skills before focusing on our kicking skills. We will create a dance based all around the Fire of London.
