AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE....

This term we will complete work on shape, look at recognising amounts of money and calculating with it, begin to be introduced to multiplication and division, and look at length and height.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will be looking at stories by the same author, Simon Bartram with the Man on the Moon series. We will also look at developing narratives with a farm theme based on a Michael Morpurgo story, as well as riddles and persuasion. We will also have a large focus on developing our written comprehension skills this term, looking for key words in the question to help us.

AS SCIENTISTS WE ARE.....

SCIENCE: Animals including humans, long term studies

We will continue our year long study of our habitat observations and comparison as well as see through the life cycle of our planted bulbs. We will also focus on the importance of keeping our bodies healthy through diet, exercise and hygiene as well as recognising what we need for survival.

GEOGRAPHY: Magical Mapping

We will look at maps and atlases, planning routes and using compass directions. We will learn how to use an atlas effectively to locate information about places and compare different maps including aerial photographs.

HISTORY: Which three queens of Britain are most remembered and why?

We will compare and contrast the reigns of 3 queens, Queen Elizabeth I, Queen Victoria and Queen Elizabeth II, looking at key events during their reigns.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Hinduism and Islam

We will look at the Hindu beliefs about one God having many forms and how Hindus worship. We will look at why Muslims believe it is important to obey Allah and how Muslims pray.

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Online Safety and Programming

We will continue our online safety work by discussing ways we can stay safe. We will create clear and precise algorithms and use these to solve problems.

AS YOUNG PEOPLE WE ARE...

PSHE: Keeping myself Safe and Rights and Respect

We will focus on looking at how we keep safe and our relationships with others. We will then focus on cooperation and self-regulation strategies.

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART: Mono Print

We will focus our drawing work on drawing tiny objects. We will look at the technique of mono print, practising this before creating our own mono prints based on an invention.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Textiles

We will be looking at designing, making and evaluating pouches using a running stitch.

MUSIC: Grandma Rap

We will compose 4-beat patterns to create a new rhythmic accompaniment, using a looping app. We will chant Grandma rap rhythmically, and perform to an accompaniment.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Games, Gymnastics, Athletics, Dance

We will look at throwing skills and tactics within games. In gymnastics we will look at strength and stability to aid our coordinated movements. In Athletics we will focus on our throwing skills, both underarm and overarm.
