AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE...

This term we will cover the following topics: Ratio, Algebra, Decimals, Fractions, Percentages, Area, Perimeter and Statistics.

AS READERS AND WRITERS....

We will be studying the work of William Shakespeare, mainly Macbeth. We will use the well know tragedy to take part in many extended writing opportunities such as newspaper reports, biographies and scene descriptions.

Later in the term, we will learn about a little boy called Auggie and the struggles he has faced attending school for the first time.

AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE...

SCIENCE: Living Things and Their Habitats

Children will learn about the classification of living things, including micro-organisms. The children will build on their work in Year 4 by sorting animals into groups based on their similarities and differences. They will extend their learning to find out about the standard system of classification first developed by Carl Linnaeus.

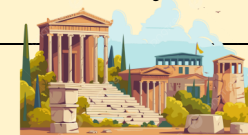
AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE...

GEOGRAPHY: The Amazon

We will take what we have learnt about rivers in our previous topic and apply it to the Amazon basin. We will also learn about rainforests, biodiversity, the tropics and climate.

HISTORY: Ancient Greece

Children will learn about the great achievements of the Ancient Greek civilisation and how their discoveries still impact our lives today. We will also be looking at the life of Alexander the Great, why was he so great?



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Islam and Christianity (Jesus)

Children will explore Islamic beliefs and the importance of the five pillars, paying specific attention to the Muslim pilgrimage of Hajj. In Christianity, children will learn about the life and sacrifice of Jesus, and how this might offer Christians comfort.

AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE.....

COMPUTING: Online Safety and Data Handling

Children will revise and revisit how to stay safe online in this ever changing world of technology and gain an understanding of big data including barcodes, QR codes, infrared and RFID technologies.

AS YOUNG PEOPLE WE ARE...

We will be learning about how we change as we grow older (Relationships and Sex Education) and how to keep ourselves safe. Pupils will also learn about their rights and responsibilities as humans, but as citizens of Great Britain too.

AS CREATORS WE ARE.....

ART & DESIGN: Print & Activism

Children are introduced to the idea that they can use art as a way of sharing their passions and interests with their peers and community. We start by introducing pupils to artists who are activists, and then we go on to help pupils identify and voice the things they care about as individuals.

LANGUAGES: En el colegio (At School)

By the end of the unit children will have the knowledge and skills to talk about the subjects they like and dislike at school (along with a justification) and at what time/day they study various subjects.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Cooking & Nutrition — Come Dine with Me!

We will be investigating complimentary flavours, designing a course for a meal and writing an easy to follow recipe.

MUSIC: Dona, nobis, pacem

Pupils will explore pulse work in 3-time, learn to sing the song as a round, learn about texture in music, and compare music with different textures.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION: Creative Games, Dance, Orienteering and Athletics.
