



AS CREATORS WE ARE...

ART: Painting and Printmaking

We will be exploring the process of making monotypes and artists who use monotypes to build sculptures. The children will have the opportunity to combine painting and collage to make a 'zine' inspired by a piece of poetry.

DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Structures

We will be identifying beam, truss and arch bridges describing their differences. We are going to design and make a sturdy bridge with triangular reinforcements.

AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE...

We will be learning about the Science fiction genre and gathering ideas from Sci-fi books and films to help us write our own short Science fiction stories to entertain another class!

After half term we will be reading a range of legends from the British Isles.
