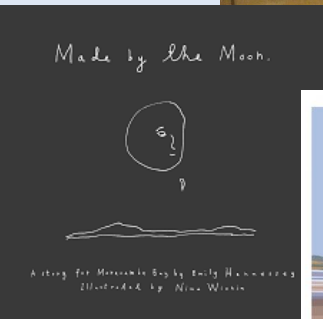
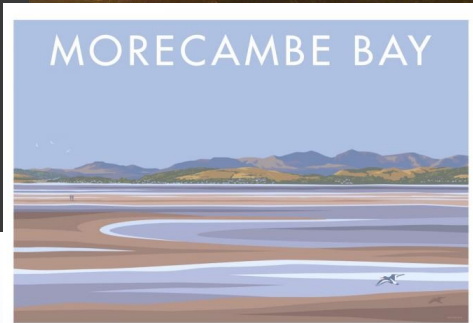


# Carters Charity Primary School Year 5 Summer Term Newsletter

### AS MATHEMATICIANS WE ARE...

This term we will be focusing on angles, coordinates and symmetry as part of our Shape work and consolidating our work on Decimals. Weekly Maths homework will consolidate the work in class—handed in on Wednesday please.

### AS READERS AND WRITERS...

We will be writing our own local legend based on existing legends.

After half-term we will be reading stories set in the Amazon Rainforest and writing our own adventure.

### AS CREATORS WE ARE...

#### ART: Architecture and Sculpture

The children will explore the responsibilities that architects and designers have to create a better world for us all, by thinking about whether we should 'Dream big or small' when it comes to planning and designing homes for the future.

#### DESIGN & TECHNOLOGY: Cooking and nutrition

We will be finding out about ingredients and nutritional content of recipes whilst practising our food preparation skills and developing a recipe.

#### MUSIC: Madina tun Nabi

We will be learning an Islamic song and develop their own accompaniment a drone, chords and improvisation.

### AS INVESTIGATORS WE ARE...

#### SCIENCE: Life Cycles

We will be learning about the Life Cycles of different types of plants and animals, and then after half-term looking at the stages of human development.

### AS ENQUIRERS WE ARE...

#### GEOGRAPHY: Our Changing World

We will be learning about different types of erosion and weathering. Then focusing on the coastline of our local area and how this could change in the future.

#### HISTORY: The Transatlantic Slave Trade

We will be finding out about the Transatlantic Slave Trade and its links to Lancaster. We will also discuss and debate important historical issues related to Slavery.

#### RELIGIOUS EDUCATION: Islam and Judaism

We will be trying to answer the questions - 'Is it fair to have to follow rules we have not made ourselves?' and 'How do people decide what to believe?'

### AS COMMUNICATORS WE ARE...

#### COMPUTING: Programming

We will be using Scratch to create a program that plays themed music.
